## **Government's Target**

"By 2012, 600 or more buses coming into operation per year will be low carbon, defined as 30% below current average carbon emissions"

# Pre-requisites for delivery of Target

#### Compatible costs

Capital + Running costs over a 5-7 year period must be similar to equivalent modern diesel bus (after initial launch phase)

#### Operational Tests

Buses need to be able to be launched in 2004/5 so that 3 years of operational experience can be gained before gearing up to production of 600+ per year



## **Working arrangements**

#### Target committee:

- •Established acceptance criteria (Well to Wheel) reduction in Greenhouse Gas Emissions
- Defined Test conditions using London Route 159

#### Regulatory & Fiscal committee:

- Identified that Manufacturers, Operators, Local Authorities and Government need to mutually commit to the introduction of Low Carbon Buses
- Identified need for a Launch Grant



## **Interim Report - July 2003**

- Set out the work done with rationale
- Asked Government to comment on the direction taken and to specifically:
  - To set up and fund an acceptance test
  - To announce that grants will be available
  - To encourage local authorities to promote Low Carbon Buses
  - To review Bus Service Operator's Grant and eliminate the negative effect of subsidised diesel fuel on the uptake of Low Carbon buses



### **Government Response**

The Minister, Tony McNulty, unveiled the Low Carbon Bus Programme at NEC on 23<sup>rd</sup> September 2003:

- Accepted test and definition of low carbon bus
- Authorised EST to verify precise criteria figures
- Provided £ 3.0 million grant funding to cover first
   150 low carbon buses
- Invited consortia of Operators and Manufacturers to submit bids by 31<sup>st</sup> December



## **Progress to date**

- First 3 manufacturers have announced and/or shown low carbon buses
- First consortium has applied for funding
- Funding application deadline extended into 2004 & 2005 or until fund used up



## **Objectives for 2004**

- Promote the take up of the Low Carbon Bus Programme
- Solve the problem of the Bus Service Operator's Grant
- Obtain the maximum involvement of Local Authorities
