Taxi measures



£20m Ultra Low Emission Taxi Infrastructure Scheme



£50m Plug-in Taxi grant – that offers up to £7.5k off the cost of a new purpose built vehicle



Upcoming exemption of premium rate VED for new zero emission capable taxis



£40m to establish Go Ultra Low Cities
