

Transport for London - Zero-Emission Bus Fleet

- TfL has made significant strides in upgrading the bus fleet to improve air quality across London
- There are now over 1,000 zero-emission buses in the fleet (consisting of electric and hydrogen buses)
- A further 700 new zero-emission buses are on order
- All new TfL buses entering the fleet are required to be zero-emission
- Around half of all garages in London will have some level of power in the next 12 months
- TfL is on track for a 100% zero-emission bus fleet by 2034 (accelerated from 2037)
- The collaboration between TfL, Bus Operators, Manufacturers and Infrastructure providers is vital to help deliver the goal of a zero-emission bus fleet in London.
