# The Go Ultra Low City Scheme

Scheme launched April 2014 as part of £500m package.

#### Aims:

Competition to support 2-4 cities with £35m of funding to:

- deliver a step change in the uptake of ULEVs in the city/region; and
- become national and international exemplars for ULEVs

#### Criteria for bids

Primary criteria:

- Step-change in ULEV uptake
- Achieving exemplar status

Secondary criteria:

- Air Quality
- Innovation
- Linking with other schemes
- Monitoring/Evaluating
