


## Physical


### **UK Market Overview**

- Historic average of 2,000-3,000 bus and coach registered annually but market shrinking since 2015
   just over 1,000 registrations in 2021 and 2022.
- Major uncertainty around passenger numbers post-Covid combined with inflationary pressures makes investment planning challenging for operators.
- Operators have begun decarbonising fleets despite these challenges, supported by significant grant funding schemes provided by UK Government and devolved administrations.
- **OUK bus industry is now leading the adoption of zero emission buses** across Europe − 50% of buses registered in 2022 and 2021 were zero emission (expected to be 50% − 60% in 2023).
- 2 Zero emission is now the standard for many operators, with battery electric technology currently accounting for the vast majority of vehicles.

## **UK Zero Emission Bus Uptake**



- For the second year running, equated to around 50% of total bus uptake in the UK.
- ② Zemo Partnership expect zero-emission registrations to account for between 50-60% of total bus uptake in 2023, with battery electric vehicles continuing to make up the majority of these vehicles.




## Battery Electric Buses In-Service by Region



Nearly 2,000 ZEBs in-service across the UK

- BEVs account for nearly 97% of all ZEBs in-service today.
- ② Over 900 in-service in London, almost 50% of UK BEV total. (Equates to over 10% of TfL fleet).
- As early adopters of ZEBs, Transport for London and operators have been key to driving uptake and technology development.
- Adoption of BEVs continues to grow in other areas of the UK too thanks to schemes like:
  - Zero Emission Bus Regional Areas (ZEBRA)
     Scheme in England
  - All Electric Bus City in England
  - ScotZEB Challenge Funds in Scotland
  - Welsh and Northern Ireland Assembly funding
